





Following the 2019 completion of a 37,500 medical office building for Monroe Carell, Jr. Children's Hospital at Vanderbilt in Murfreesboro, Tn., our team started a 31,000 SF facility in Hendersonville for Vanderbilt University Medical Center that will offer adult outpatient specialty care, limited pediatric specialty care, and imaging services.
